To any of the Constables of the Town of Dover in said County, Greetings:

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Dover, qualified as the Constitution requires to vote in elections and in Town affairs, to assemble at the Town House in said Town on Monday, the 12<sup>th</sup> of June, 2023, at seven o'clock in the forenoon, then and there to vote by ballot on the following Article, to wit:

**Shall the Town of Dover be allowed to exempt from the provisions of proposition two and one-half, so called, the amount required to pay for the bond issued in order to undertake the following projects:**

- **additional costs for the construction and renovation of the Caryl Community Center; and**
- **an outdoor recreation court and swing area for the Caryl Community Center;**

**such amounts to include the cost of architectural and engineering services related to those improvements and for the payment of all other costs incidental and related thereto?**

For these purposes the polls will be open at seven o'clock in the forenoon and will close at eight o'clock in the evening.

And you are directed to serve this Warrant by (1) posting attested copies thereof on each of the bulletin boards erected in the Town House, at the Post Office, and in no less than three (3) other Public places where bills and notices are usually posted; and (2) mailing a copy thereof to or leaving same at the residence of every registered voter fourteen (14) days at least before the time of holding said Meeting.

Hereof fail not and make due return of the Warrant with your doings thereon to the Town Clerk at or before the time of the Meeting.
