

I defer the suggestions and conclusions of this report as they relate to public safety to our Police Department's review. However I would like to highlight two areas of concern.

First, the Sight Distance Analysis conclusion states that the minimum distance requirements are met but remains silent on meeting or exceeding the Desirable Distances of Intersection Sight Distances (Table 5, page 18). A recommendation specific to "Vehicles exiting the Site Drive, looking west" seems to be appropriate due to the fact that the measured distance does not meet minimum required at the 85th percentile travel speeds nor the Desirable distances at posted speed or 85th percentile travel speeds.

And lastly the Conclusions and Recommendations (page 19) contains more than a few recommended actions to place various permanent new signs in the area of the Dunkin Donuts. I would like to reiterate the Board of Selectmen's position regarding signage and that is to minimize the number of signs in the Town. Please consider the issue of signage as it relates to this proposal and future proposed projects.
